1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 223, s. 2026, entitled "Participation of the ZPRAA Delegation to the 2026 Palarong Pambansa," and Regional Memorandum No. 260, s. 2026, entitled "Addendum on the Participation of the ZPRAA Delegation to the 2026 Palarong Pambansa," this Office announces the participation of the DACAA athletes and officials in the said activity from May 19 to June 1, 2026, in Agusan del Sur Province.

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3. Participants to this activity are the private and public elementary and secondary school qualified athletes, coaches, chaperons and officials of different sports events (See Annex A).
4. The training of qualified athletes for team events shall be conducted and facilitated by the winning coach, while individual events shall be facilitated by the Division under the supervision of the Division Sports Coordinator and the Assistant Division Sports Coordinator, and the in-house training for all ZANDIDAA qualified athletes shall be conducted from May 9 to 17, 2026 at the Olingan Sports Complex, Olingan, Dipolog City.
5. Coaches are encouraged to bring their respective sports equipment, implements, apparatus, and other sports supplies for the training period, and athletes, coaches, and other involved officials must also bring their own dining essentials and sleeping gear.
6. Members of the Training Mess Committee shall report to the training venue from May 8 to 17, 2026 at Olingan, Dipolog City (see Annex B).
7. Teachers who will serve during Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays shall be granted Vacation Service Credits, subject to the provisions stipulated under DepEd Order No. 013, s. 2024. Likewise, School Heads and non-teaching personnel shall be provided with Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC) pursuant to CSC and DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004.
8. The costs for playing uniforms, food, and local transportation during the modular/centralized training, as well as the transportation expenses and food incurred by the participants while traveling from their residences to the designated departure stations, shall be charged against the Special Education Fund (SEF), School/Division MOOE, Program Support Fund (PSF), and other available sources of funds. Meanwhile, the travel expenses from the designated departure stations to the competition venue, including food, return travel, and all other related costs and expenses during participation, shall be covered by national funds and the regular MOOE/ROP, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
