PARTICIPATION TO THE 33RD GSP REGIONAL CAMP

1. Pursuant to the WM Circular No. 17, s. 2025 titled 33rd GSP Regional Camp, the Girl Scouts of the Philippines (GSP) will conduct its **33rd GSP Regional Camp** with the theme : “From Service to Action, Girl Scouts Lead the Way” at **Jardin de las Niñas Regional Program & Training Center, Cabatangan, Zamboanga City** on **February 5-9, 2026**.
2. Qualifications of the participants to this activity are as follows:
 - A. Girls – must be a registered Junior/Senior Girls Scout as of January 2026
 - must be physically fit and alert
 - must have earned at least one badge each under the 8-Point Challenge
 - must have attended a troop/patrol/council/camp prior to this camp
 - B. Adult – currently registered Troop Leader
 - Preferably a Campcraft Certificate Holder
 - must be physically and mentally fit
3. To ensure balanced representation across all levels of the division’s scouting program, the participant allocation are as follows:
 - Junior Girl Scout: 3 representatives from each district
 - Senior Girl Scout: 1 representative from each secondary or integrated school within the division
 - Adult Leaders: 3 secondary-level adult leaders and 4 elementary-level adult leaders, who will oversee and guide the scout participants throughout the camp duration



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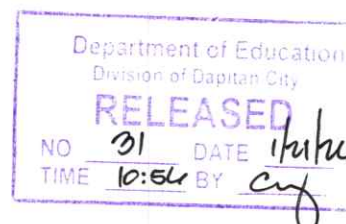




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4. The registration fee of Nine Hundred Pesos (P900.00) that will be collected from each participant to cover the program materials, Camper's Guide, certificates, badge/s, camp souvenirs, group insurance, and transportation during offsite activities.
5. This Office reiterates that participation of learners and teachers in this activity is voluntary. The school heads of the participating schools shall take full responsibility in ensuring compliance to DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 titled Instituting Measures to Increased Time-On Tasks and Ensuring Compliance Therewith and DepEd Order No. 66, s. 2017, re: Implementing Guidelines on the Conduct of Off-Campus Activities.
6. Registration Fees, food, travel and incidental/miscellaneous expenses incurred in participation to this activity are chargeable against the Special Education Fund/Local Funds subject to availability and to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. Teachers who will render services during Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays shall be granted Vacation Service Credits subject to the provision stipulated under DepEd Order No. 013m s. 2024. Likewise, School Heads and non-teaching personnel shall be provided with Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) pursuant to CSC and DBM Joint Circular No. 2, 2024.

Please be informed of the scheduled **33rd GSP REGIONAL CAMP** on **February 5-9, 2026**, with the theme: "From Service to Action, Girl Scouts Lead the Way" at Jardin de las Niñas Regional Program & Training Center, Cabatangan, Zamboanga City.

Hereunder is the initial information about the event.

PARTICIPANTS: A patrol of Junior/Senior/Cadet Girl Scouts or more with Adult Leaders

QUALIFICATIONS OF PARTICIPANTS

GIRL:

1. Must be a registered Junior/Senior Girl Scout as of January 2026.
2. Must be physically fit and alert.
3. Must have earned at least one badge each under the 8-Point Challenge.
4. Must have attended a troop/patrol/council/camp prior to this camp.

ADULT:

1. Currently registered Troop Leader.
2. Preferably a Campcraft Certificate Holder.
3. Must be physically and mentally fit.

CAMP FEE

1. The camp fee is **Nine Hundred Pesos (P900.00)** per camper inclusive of program materials Camper's Guide, certificates, badge/s, camp souvenirs, group insurance, and transportation during offsite activities.

ARRIVAL IN CAMP

1. The campers are expected to arrive in camp in the morning of **Thursday, February 5**.
2. Upon arrival, the campers shall proceed to the Camp Registration Area to register with the Business Manager.
3. The Sub Camp Program Coordinator will give instructions as to their sub-camp and unit assignments as well as the location where they will pitch their tents. The camp layout will be posted on the bulletin board for reference.

FOOD MANAGEMENT

1. The food of the campers is **NOT** included in the registration fee.

2. There will be a Trading Post inside the camp where the campers can order in advance and buy their marketing needs. Procedures on how to order and purchase perishable goods/food supplies will be discussed by the Sub-Camp Quarter Master during the orientation.
3. Campers should bring their individual refillable water bottle or tumbler, eating utensils, and set of cooking utensils for each patrol.
4. **LPG/kerosene/butane stove** will not be allowed inside the camp.
