The 10,000 SM more or less (1 hectare) donation of Former Congressman Romeo "Nonong" Jalosjos, Sr. for the proposed Aliguay Secondary School was a manifestation of his deep and sincere concern for education; the latest information from HT Belmor Debaloy of Dampalan ES that the campus B of Dampalan ES shall be utilized for the building of the secondary students currently in Dampalan ES Extension; and as of the latest LSB Meeting on December 2, 2021, the payment for the school site for the proposed Sigayan Secondary School is being processed (SDS had already signed the documents for payment) are developments that the current leaders of Dapitan City are for quality, relevant, liberating education accessible to all.

Why SECONDARY SCHOOLS, not National High Schools?

The National High School, as it is now, usually has two components; 1) Junior High School and 2) Senior High School. The term National High School refers to the Junior High School, Grades 7 to 10, so that a separate permit, or authority to operate for the Senior High School was/is needed. The creation of Aliguay,

Dampalan and Sigayan shall be ALIGUAY SECONDARY SCHOOL, DAMPALAN SECONDARY SCHOOL and SIGAYAN SECONDARY SCHOOL to make these three (3) new SECONDARY SCHOOLS inclusive for both the Junior High School and Senior High School components.

To start formally the processing of the creation of these 3 new SECONDARY SCHOOLS, we meet in Baylimango CES on December 10 (F), 2021 beginning at 9:00AM – I am confident that PIC Belen Talic is willing to accommodate us in any space available considering that Baylimango CES is among the two schools implementing the Pilot Limited Face-to-Face Classes.

### Some of the Basic Requirements:

- 1. Feasibility Study which includes among others
  - a) Availability of the School Site,
  - b) Parents commitment to send their children to respective school,
  - Barangay Resolution/commitment to support the school with makeshift building and the like while the school is in transition for its full creation,
- 2. City Council Resolution/commitment to support the school for locally paid teachers, makeshift building/classrooms and others in transition,
- 3. Congress allocating budget through Republic Act,
- 4. Etc.
