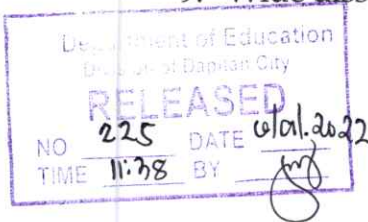

**ADMINISTRATION OF THE REVISED PHIL-INFORMAL READING INVENTORY  
(PHIL-IRI) POST TEST AND SUBMISSION OF REPORTS**

**June 8, 2022**

1. In support to the goal of the Department of Education in making every child a reader and writer at his Grade Level, this office requires all schools to administer the Revised Philippine Informal Reading Inventory (Phil-IRI) Post Test from June 1-17, 2021.
2. The assessment aims to gather authentic data for planning, designing/redesigning the reading instruction of teachers and school's reading programs to all public elementary and secondary schools in this division.
3. Materials in the conduct of assessment and template of reports can be access through the Google Drive provided by the Division in-charge of LRM.
4. All students in Grade 3 to 6 and 7-10 will undergo the Group Screening Test in Filipino while students in Grades 4-6 and 7-10 will undergo GST in English. Students identified to be performing below level of expectation (those with a total Raw Score below 14) should undergo further assessment through the individually administered Phil-IRI graded passages. Group assessment must be conducted within class time while individual assessment may be conducted outside class hours.
5. All Filipino and English subject teachers can administer the Phil-IRI graded passages in their respective classes. ELLN trained teachers should assist in administering the inventory.
6. School heads are also task to conduct supervision and provide technical assistance in the administration of the assessment.
7. The deadline of submission of required reports is on or before **June 21, 2022** c/o EPS Lindo O. Adasa, Jr, the Division Reading Coordinator.
8. District offices are task to consolidate data submitted by schools using the given template from RO 9.
9. Wide dissemination and compliance of this Memorandum is desired.
