1. Scouting with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) is an effective co-curricular program in the leadership and value formation of every child, Its main objective is consistent with the Department of Education's mission to develop every boy and every young man into a well-rounded individual with exemplary character worth of emulation of school children. The BSP has consistently produced leaders and role models who are true advocates of the Scout Oath and Law.
2. In support to the National Office Memorandum # 53 s. 2022, RE: Scouts go green, In Celebration of BSP's 86th Year Founding Anniversary, this division announces the conduct of Simultaneous School-based BSP Encampment in their respective schools on October 14, 2022.
3. The objective of the School Encampment is to provide a "Progressive, Safe and Enjoyable Learning Environment" for the scouts to enhance their physical, social, mental, emotional and spiritual potentials.
4. Anent to this, all Boy Scouts are encouraged to plant indigenous and endemic trees, flower and fruit bearing trees for schools, homes, public parks and mangrove trees for coastal areas.
5. Action Report, with details on the number of trees planted, number of participants, location and other necessary information with pictorials must be reported and submitted to the Division Office not later than 15 November 2022 or one month after the conduct of the activity, c/o Scouter Danilo Santiago.
6. Surrogate Supervisors are required to monitor/supervise the encampment program of activities in their respective assigned district.
7. Expenses relative to the activity shall be charged to PTA funds or local scouts' funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. Additional and other details of the said encampment will be issued from time to time.
