- As reiterated in DepEd Order No. 34, s. 2022, titled School Calendar and Activities for School Year 2022-2023 and DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 or Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-On-Tasks and Ensuring Compliance Therewith, all school heads are instructed to see to it that the said Orders are properly followed.
- 2. The current situation of the Basic Education system of our country brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic shall focus on the learning recovery measures as we embrace the resumption of full in-person classes in all schools.
- Academic and non-academic competitions, sports meets, and other contests, including the practices and training of such activities, shall be allowed, provided that they will be held outside class hours, on weekends, or during breaks, in a way classes are not disrupted.
- 4. All Elementary and Secondary School Heads are directed to prioritize implementing learning recovery measures and focus on the full implementation of in-person classes. Likewise, all EPS, PSDS and PICDs shall monitor such implementation in all schools in this division.
- 5. Widest dissemination and strict compliance of this memorandum is expected.
