TO: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent CID/SGOD Chiefs EPS in English and Filipino Public Schools District Supervisors Elementary/Secondary School Heads This Division

- 1. DepEd Dapitan City in collaboration with the concerned division/sections crafted and issues the Division Learning Recovery and Continuity Plan (DLRCP) to address and mitigate the gaps and losses brought by the health pandemic.

- 4. The preparation of ISP on Reading should be based on the reading assessment results and implement it in schools especially those requiring urgent assistance.
- 5. Deadline of submission of said reading plan will be on or before November 25, 2022 through the district supervisor addressed to the Schools Division Superintendent, attention: Division Reading Coordinator.
