2. The activity aims to promote academic excellence in Science through competitions, camaraderie and sportsmanship.

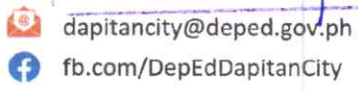

RULES & MECHANICS	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Participants are bona fide Elementary and Secondary students of this division. 2. There shall be three rounds for all categories: EASY, AVERAGE & DIFFICULT. Clincher will be done in case of a tie. There shall be five (5) Easy, 5 Average and 5 Difficult questions. All contestants shall answer all questions in the 3 rounds. Each correct answer in every round will be given corresponding points to wit: Easy – 1 point Average – 2 points Difficult – 3 points 3. Each question must be answered within the time allocated for it. 10 seconds for Easy and Average rounds, 20 seconds for Difficult rounds. 4. The quizmaster shall read each question twice and the time shall start only after the quizmaster says “go”. 5. The contestants may begin to answer only after the quizmaster says “go”. 6. The contestants must write his/her final answer on the answer sheet/writing paper. If a contestant wishes to change his/her answer, the first answer should be crossed-out and the final answer will be encircled. 7. All answers must be spelled out correctly to be considered correct. If the answer is a proper noun, capitalization of the first letter of the word is also a basis in declaring a correct answer. 8. The contestant with the highest final score shall be declared as the champion, second highest is the second placer, third highest is the third placer. 9. The duly registered coach of the contestant is the only person authorized to file a protest. All protest should be referred to the Board of Judges before the quizmaster reads the next question. No protest shall be entertained by the Board of Judges when the quizmaster started reading the next question. 10. Any violation of the aforementioned rules shall cause the disqualification of the concerned.

RULES & MECHANICS	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Set the starting position of the chips.one minute to move, record the move and score. 2. The two players alternately will take turns in moving a piece (pass is not allowed). 3. Touch move shall be observed in the games. A player who touches a chip is required to move that chip unless it is an illegal move. 4. After making a move, a player shall record his/her move in the scoresheet. 5. Only one scoresheet will be used by the players in a game. 6. Each player is allowed one minute to move, record the move and score. 7. A warning is given to a player by the arbiter if no move is made in one minute consequently, is forced to move a chip. 8. Continuous violation of rule #7 will mean disqualification (after 3 warnings) of the player regardless of their scores. 9. All moves should be in the forward direction except when taking a chip or the chip is "DAMA". 10. A chip is declared "DAMA" if it reaches and stops in any of the following opponent's square: <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around; margin: 5px 0;"> (1,0) (3,0) (5,0) (7,0) </div> Similarly, if an ordinary opponent's chip reaches the following squares, it is declared as "DAMA", <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around; margin: 5px 0;"> (0,7) (2,7) (4,7) (6,7) </div> 11. Once a piece/chip is declared as a "DAMA", it could slide diagonally forward or backward in any vacant square. If a "DAMA" takes a chip, the score is doubled, similarly if a chip takes a "DAMA" the score is also doubled. If the "DAMA" takes a "DAMA", the score is quadrupled. 12. "DAMA" chip should be encircled in the score sheet to identify the "dama". 13. Games duration should not exceed twenty minutes. 14. The game also ends if: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The moves are repetitive • A player has no more chips to move • A player has no more chips • A player resigns. <p>"Saved by the bell" is not applicable in the end game. Continuation of the move shall be enforced when taking a chip/s.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 15. The remaining chip/s of a player is/are added to his total score algebraically. 16. If the remaining chip is a "dama", the value is doubled. 17. The player with the lesser total score wins the game. 18. Only players are allowed to raise questions during the game through the arbiter and questions should be settled immediately. No questions will be entertained after the game. 19. Arbiter's decision is final.
