





On behalf of the College of Social Science and Philosophy (CSSP)-UP Diliman, I would like to cordially invite the faculty members and researchers in your institution to participate in the 2023 CSSP Extramural Training Seminar for Social Science Teachers (CSSPEx 2023) to be held on August 3-5 at the University of the Philippines Diliman. This Extramural Training Seminar is our college's primary extension activity and is aimed at strengthening the capabilities of those handling courses in the social sciences and philosophy at the K to 12 Program, as well as those who are engaged in teaching General Education courses at the tertiary level.

This year's CSSPEx theme is **Social Sciences and Philosophy Research in Post-Pandemic Era: Ethics**, **Privacy**, **and Methods**, underscoring the need to equip the participants with more thorough knowledge of the various research methods employed in the disciplines within the domain of the social sciences and philosophy. The opening day of the 2023 CSSP Extrams will feature a keynote lecture by CSSP Dean Maria Bernadette L. Abrera on the story of the social sciences and philosophy education in the context of the Philippines in the morning. In the afternoon, the panel discussions and plenary lecture focus on the following: (1) academic journal management and the publishing process, (2) data privacy, and (3) research ethics, and establishing an ethics review board. The remaining two days will be devoted to parallel sessions featuring specific social science research methods per breakout group. The workshop speakers and facilitators will be coming from the College of Social Sciences and Philosophy of UP Diliman.

The Department of Education issued on March 2, 2023, DepEd Memorandum 12, s. 2023 or the Moratorium on the Implementation of DepEd Order No. 001, s. 2020 (Guidelines for NEAP Recognition of Professional Development Programs and Courses for Teachers and School Leaders). DepEd shall no longer issue advisory on training programs, for such will now be subject to the voluntary participation of teachers and school leaders.
