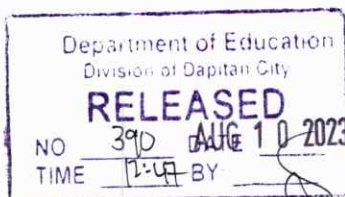

SEMINAR WORKSHOP ON THE ENHANCEMENT OF SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN (SIP) FOR CY 2023-2028 cum DATA MANAGEMENT AND INFORMATION REQUIREMENTS WORKSHOP

1. With the emergence of the Basic Education Development (BEDP) 2030, Regional Education Development Plan (REDP) 2023-2028, and Division Education Development Plan (DEDP) 2023-2028 and with the launch of the new DepEd Administration's MATATAG Agenda: *Bansang Makabata, Batang Makabansa*, which set the new direction of the agency and stakeholders in resolving basic education challenges, there is a need to integrate and align the strategic goals and outcomes down to the school level through the enhancement of the School Improvement Plan (SIP).
2. In line with this, a **Seminar-Workshop on the Enhancement of School Improvement Plan (SIP) cum Data Management and Information Requirements Workshop** shall be held on **August 16, 2023**, Wednesday, 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at Ariana Hotel, Minaog, Dipolog City.
3. The workshop aims:
 - a. To facilitate cohesion, unity, and interconnectedness of quality basic education planning from the highest governance level (CO) to school level; and
 - b. To ensure seamless integration and alignment of the MATATAG Agenda and the Four Pillars (Access, Equity, Quality, Resiliency & Well-Being) and Governance as enabling mechanism for sustainability to the Basic Education Development Plan (BEDP), Regional Education Development Plan (REDP), Division Education Development Plan (DEDP) and School Improvement Plan (SIP).
4. Participants to this activity are School Heads of public elementary, secondary, and integrated schools of Dapitan City Schools Division. Attendees are required to bring laptop and extension cord, and copies of the previous cycle of the school's SIP.
