
- 1. Acknowledging the subject's crucial role in shaping students' understanding of their nation's history, culture, and social dynamics, and underscoring the imperative for teachers to actively promote citizenship and nurture critical thinking in today's educational environment, this Division seeks to empower Araling Panlipunan teachers in secondary schools by conducting a specialized activity entitled, "Capacity Building & Exposition of Project Citizen Cum Launching Project C.H.E.N." on December 7-9, 2023.
- 2. This activity aims to: a) create a comprehensive lesson plan connecting Araling Panlipunan with at least three other subjects; b) show proficiency in Project Citizen methods by guiding students in addressing a social issue; c) strengthen commitment as positive change agents through a "teaching for citizenship" manifesto promoting citizenship, critical thinking, and empathy; d) ensure 60% female attendance and provide sessions on sensitive gender issues; and e) promote inclusivity with accessible materials, cultural dialogue, and diverse narratives in Araling Panlipunan instruction.
- 3. Participants to this activity are selected secondary school teachers handling Araling Panlipunan. Please see attached list.
- 4. Expenses incurred in the conduct of the activity such as meals, snacks, and venue shall be charged to 2023 Special Education Fund (SEF), while transportation and incidental expenses shall be charged to school MOOE and other school local funds subject to its availability and usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
