2023 CELEBRATION OF INTERNATIONAL MEN'S DAY

This Division

1. Every November, the world celebrates International Men's Day to emphasize the positive roles and values that men provide to the world, their families, and communities, as well as to promote awareness of men's well-being, with this year's theme "Zero Male Suicide."
2. International Men's Day was first suggested by Dr. Jerome Teelucksingh in the early 1990s to honor men's accomplishments, and it was officially marked on November 19, 1999.
3. To provide perspective to this campaign, homeroom teachers/advisers are to undertake one or more of the following activities integrating it in the lesson/s of the day during the month of November.
 - a) **Appreciation Cards:** Have students create appreciation cards for male figures in their lives, expressing gratitude for the positive contributions they make.
 - b) **Role Model Sharing:** Encourage students to share stories about male role models who have inspired them, whether it's a family member, teacher, or public figure.
 - c) **Collaborative Art Project:** Engage students in a collaborative art project where they create a mural or collage that represents positive qualities and achievements associated with men.
 - d) **Career Exploration:** Invite male professionals from various fields to speak to the class about their careers, providing students with insights into different occupations and the diverse contributions of men.
 - e) **Storytelling Circle:** Foster a storytelling session where students can share anecdotes or write short stories about positive experiences with the important men in their lives.
 - f) **Discussion on Stereotypes:** Facilitate a class discussion about stereotypes related to men and encourage students to reflect on how these stereotypes may influence their perceptions.
 - g) **Guest Speaker Series:** Arrange for a guest speaker, such as a male author, athlete, or community leader, to share their experiences and insights with the students.
4. Schools/teachers are encouraged to post activity highlights conducted with the hashtag #DepEdDapitanInternationalMensDay2023

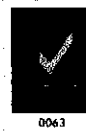
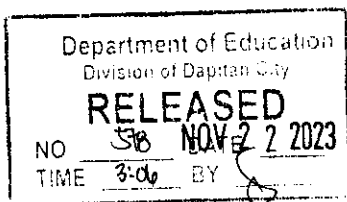
