**ACTIVITIES IN OBSERVANCE OF THE WORLD WATER DAY 2024
IN PARTNERSHIP WITH DAPITAN CITY WATER DISTRICT**

1. In observance of the World Water Day 2024 celebration, the Dapitan City Water District, in partnership with the Schools Division of Dapitan City, will hold a series of activities, including a symposium and various contests, on March 22, 2024 at Dapitan City National High School from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm.
2. Bearing the theme "Water for Peace," the activity focuses on the critical role that water plays in the stability and prosperity of the world, and aims to increase students' awareness on the value of fresh water resources and hone their talents and skills.
3. Participants in the said symposium and contests are junior or senior high school learners from the secondary schools of DepEd Dapitan City. Schools shall only send four (4) learners and one (1) teacher-coach. These students are also the participants of the four contests in the afternoon, namely: a. extemporaneous speech, b. on-the-spot slogan making, c. poster-making, and d. essay writing. Schools have one (1) participant per contest. The remaining slots of participants for the symposium shall be coming from Dapitan City National High School.
4. Participants are preferably learners from Grade 7 to 11 to prioritize the conduct of NAT 12 which falls on the same date and to avoid disruptions of classes in preparation for the Third Quarter Examination and the conduct of Catch Up Fridays.

We trust that this intention is aligned with your agency's development thrust and objectives, hence, a meaningful collaboration is earnestly requested.

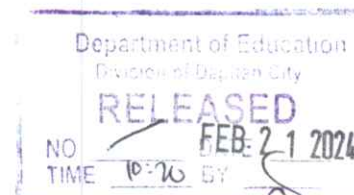

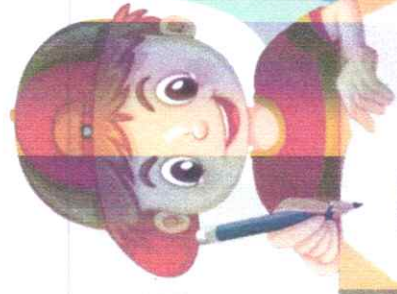
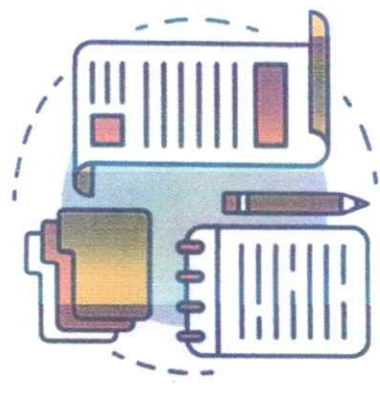
ESSAY WRITING

- Open to all Junior and Senior High School students within Dapitan City.
- Only one (1) participant per school is allowed.
- The contest will be held in the afternoon of March 22, 2024, at Dapitan City National High School to be conducted by Dapitan City Water District, in line with the celebration of the World Water Day 2024.
- The board of judges shall provide the topic of the essay at the venue of the competition.
- The contestants shall be given One(1) hour to develop the composition.
- The medium of language used shall be English.
- The contestant shall be provided with a pen and a long bond paper marked with the assigned number duly signed by the contest master.
They are prohibited to write their names and College/s they are representing.
- No printed materials, electronic gadgets, or storage devices shall be utilized.
- The result of the contestant shall be posted on the tally board immediately after the judges have finished rating the contestant's manuscript.
- The judge's decision is final.

MECHANICS & RULES

1. Open to all Junior and Senior High School students within Dapitan City.
2. Only One (1) participant per School is allowed.
3. The contest will be held in the afternoon of March 22, 2024, at Dapitan City National High School to be conducted by Dapitan City Water District, in line with the celebration of the World Water Day 2024.
4. Each participant shall submit One (1) ORIGINAL entry, and the poster must revolve around the World Water Day 2024 theme: "LEVERAGING WATER FOR PEACE".
5. Participants should bring their own drawing/coloring materials, which could be anything of their liking.

6. A pre-numbered 1/2 size illustration board, which will be used as canvas for the poster making, will be provided by DapCWD on the contest proper.

7. A piece of paper will also be provided to the participant for a short-written explanation of their poster (in Cebuano, English or Filipino), intended to aid the judges in interpreting the artworks and choosing the winners.

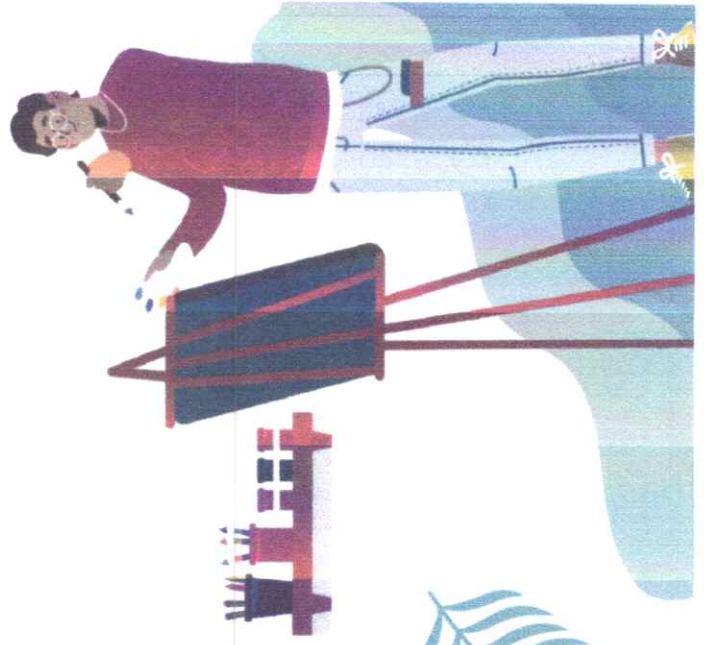
8. The contestants will be given 1 hour and 30 minutes to complete their work.

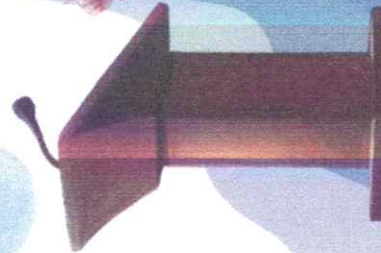
EXTEMPORANEOUS SPEECH

MECHANICS & RULES

1. Open to all Junior and Senior High School students within Dapitan City.
2. Only One (1) participant per school is allowed.
3. The contest will be held in the afternoon of March 22, 2024, at Dapitan City National High School to be conducted by Dapitan City Water District, in line with the celebration of the World Water Day 2024.
4. The topic shall be given by the judges One(1) hour prior to the start of the competition.
 - a. The Judges shall give topics related to current events whether local, national, or international.
5. The contestants shall be given 5 minutes to deliver.
 - a. The medium of language used shall be English.
 - b. The contestants are not allowed to have any gadget.
 - c. A timer accessible to the contestant, judges, and audience shall be provided.
 - d. The contestants master is accountable to the sanctification of the competition.
 - e. There will be a 1-point deduction for every 30-seconds overtime from the respective judge's total score before determining the rank of the contestants.
6. The style of the delivery shall be conversational, oratorical, or a combination of both.
 - a. Dramatic style is considered disqualified.
7. The contestant should wear their respective school uniform.
8. Use of sound effects, microphones, and props is disallowed.
9. After the deliberation of the members of the board of judges, the judge's decision is final.

4. Stage presence (eye contact, poise, personality)	10%

Slogan Making Contest

1. Open to all Junior and Senior High School students within Dapitan City.
2. Only One (1) participant per School is allowed.
3. The contest will be held in the afternoon of March 22, 2024, at Dapitan City National High School to be conducted by Dapitan City Water District, in line with the celebration of the World Water Day 2024.
4. The theme for the slogan making will be given on the contest proper.
5. Each participant shall submit One (1) entry only.
6. The SLOGAN must strictly consist of maximum of 20 words.
7. Cebuano, English or Filipino may be used as medium for this contest.
8. The slogan must be an original work of every participant and not copied from anywhere else.
9. Participants should bring their own writing /coloring materials, which could be anything of their liking.
10. A pre-numbered 1/2 size illustration board, which will be used for the slogan making, will be provided by DapCWD on the contest proper.
11. The contestants will be given 1 hour to complete their work.
12. Decision of the judges shall be final and non-appealable.
13. All entries will become a property of DapCWD after the contest.
