STRENGTHENING THE UTILIZATION OF ALTERNATIVE DELIVERY METHODS IN SCHOOLS TO MITIGATE THE IMPACT OF THE EL NINO PHENOMENON AND OTHER DRY SPELL-INDUCED DISASTERS

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Chief Education Supervisors (CID, and SGOD)
Education Program Supervisors, PSDSs, and PICDs
All Secondary School Principals and Head Teachers
All Others Concerned

1. In light of the dry spell and high heat index experienced in our country brought about by the El Nino Phenomenon, this office issues the Guidelines for the adoption of alternative delivery modality or blended learning modality in schools.
2. Schools that decide to adopt an alternative delivery mode or blended learning modality due to high heat index experience in their barangays, the following should be done:
 - a. **Enhanced Master Program aligned with the adopted ADM**
 - b. **Submit Reports to the PSDS about the adoption of ADM**
3. Teachers are still required to report to schools to ensure the continuous delivery of quality teaching and learning. Moreover, teachers should find means of communication to keep them updated on the tasks and modules assigned to the learners. School Heads and other non-teaching personnel must report to schools to continue school operations.
4. Public Schools District Supervisors are required to submit reports of schools that implement ADM in the office of the CID and SGOD re: Adoption of Alternative Delivery Modality.
5. These are the suggested modalities that can be adopted:
 - a. **Online Learning**
 - b. **Face-to-Face Instruction**
 - c. **Blended Learning**
6. Also, if the Local Government Unit declares a suspension of classes, the following modalities will still be adopted.



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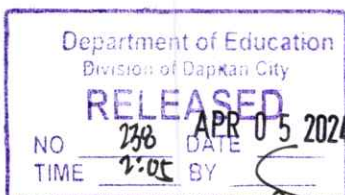
