- A Registration Fee of ONE THOUSAND PESOS (Php 1,000.00) to cover for meals & snacks for 3 days, conference materials and others.
- Registration, travel and other incidental expenses relative to the participation to this activity shall be charged against SEF/Local Funds, PTA Funds, School BSP Sustaining Funds, Local Scout Funds and other sources of funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- Teacher participants shall receive Service Credits during Saturdays, Sundays and holidays subject to the provision stipulated under DECS Memorandum No. 143, s. 1997. Likewise, School Heads and non-teaching personnel shall be provided with Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC) per CSC and DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004.
