

- 1. Pursuant to Memorandum DM-OUHROD-2024-0037, Re: Guidelines on the Conduct of In-Service Training For Teachers (INSET) for School Year 2023-2024. This division will conduct In-service Training for Teachers on January 24-26, and January 29-30, 2024.
