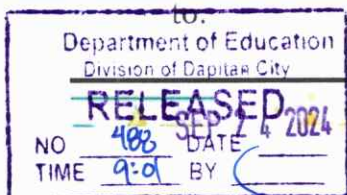

Science Activities for School Year 2024-2025

1. Proclamation No. 264 of September 23, 2002, declaring September every year as the National Science Club Month, and authorizing the DepED, DOST-SEI, PSYSC and SCAAP to implement plans and activities pertinent thereto.
2. DepEd Advisory No. 043, s. 2024, dated July 19, 2024, the Association of Science Educators in the Philippines (ASEP) announces the conduct of 21st National Science Quest, at the Skyrise Hotel and Baguio Teachers Camp, Baguio City on February 21-23, 2025 with the theme *"Harnessing Scientific Innovation to Build a Resilient and Sustainable Future"*.
3. Anent thereto, SDO Dapitan City acknowledges the conduct of suggested classroom-based or school-based activities and contest and other instructional events for school year 2024-2025. Schools are encouraged to organize significant and meaningful activities related to the theme starting September 2024 up to the end of the school year 2024-2025.
4. The objective of this activity is to ensure that students not only acquire scientific knowledge but also develop the skills and attitudes necessary to become responsible and reflective citizens aligned with the MATATAG Curriculum, emphasizing the development of critical thinking, problem solving skills, and scientific literacy.
5. Science Club advisers and members of science and environment related clubs (YES-O Club, Research Club, Robotics Club) shall spearhead the conduct of science activities in the school.
6. Science Club advisers are expected to submit activity proposal and accomplishment report (*see template*) on the activities conducted not later than December 31, 2024 for 1st and 2nd Quarters and March 31, 2025 for 3rd and 4th quarters via: <https://formurl.com/to/ScienceActivitiesReport>

8. Schools may alter, modify, change, add, design, create other activities or adopt the ASEP categories for competition, provided in DepEd Advisory No. 043, s. 2024
9. Winners in school level contest may participate to the division, regional, and national level contest, provided there are MOV's to prove the conduct of school level contest and/or district level contest. Guidelines shall be issued in a separate issuance.
10. Participation of learners and teachers shall be purely voluntary and must not interfere with instructional time, in compliance with DepEd Order No. 3, s. 2023, also known as "Allowing the Conduct of In-Person Activities and DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2002 titled "Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-On-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith."
11. Participation of teachers and learners is also subject to "no collection policy" as stated in Republic Act 5546, which prohibits the sale of tickets and/or collection of contributions for whatever project or purpose from students and teachers of public and private schools, colleges and universities.
12. Videos and pictures during these activities may be shared on the FB page of the school to showcase the learners' outputs and participation subject to Republic Act 10173 also known as Data Privacy Act of 2012.
13. Expenses relative to the conduct of science activities shall be charged against school MOOE/local funds subject to the availability, and usual government and accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
