PARTICIPATION TO THE 1st PNVF U21 NATIONAL VOLLEYBALL **CHAMPIONSHIPS**

- 1. In response to the Invitation Letter of the Philippine National Volleyball Federation (PNVF) partnership with Philippine Sports Commission (PSC) and the Philippine Olympic Committee (POC), re; the opening of the 1st PNVF U21 National Volleyball Championships, this office encourages the participation of the Volleyball Clubs in schools in the elimination tournament based on the following schedule, to wit;
 - A. October 20, 2024 (Sunday) @7:30am-5:00pm -DCNHS Covered Court -Selection of athletes for Volleyball Men Teams
 - B. October 27, 2024 (Sunday) @7:30am-5:00pm -DCNHS Covered Court -Selection of athletes for Volleyball Women Teams
 - C. November 3 or 10, 2024 -Regional Finals at Ipil, Zamboanga Sibugay
- 2. The participation aims to provide a wider opportunity of the athletes for an exposure to the local and national competitions and develop values in sports which are essential in participating higher competitions and to create one (1) volleyball team for men and One (1) volleyball team for women to compete in the Regional Finals.
- 3. Participants to this event are those athletes born on February 1, 2004 (for men) or later and June 1, 2004 (for women) or later to qualify for the Championships.
- 4. All interested Secondary and Integrated Schools who will participate in the tournament shall follow the guidelines on the eligibility to qualify and the provisions in DO No. 66, s. 2017.
- 5. Interested athletes shall bring Parents' Consent, Medical Certificate and PSA Certificate of Live Birth for the verification of the qualification to compete.







The Philippine National Volleyball Federation partnership with Philippine Sports Commission (PSC) and Philippine Olympic Committee (POC) hereby informs all its members and stakeholders that the 1st **PNVF U21 NATIONAL VOLLEYBALL CHAMPIONSHIPS** is now open for entries. We cordially invite your Men and Women teams to take part in this national tournament.

The competition for both genders is scheduled to start on Sept 28, 2024 at the different venues and regions of the country. **Provincial/City and/or Regional Finals** tournaments will be conducted, the champion team will spearhead and represent the (province/city to the regional to the Mindanao Finals). Top 2 teams of the Mindanao Finals will qualify to the National Championships on January 2025 to be held in Manila.

A maximum of 16 teams per division shall be accepted, with the following conditions:

- 1. Participants must be physically fit and certified by a doctor through the M-3 form.
- 2. Players must be born on February 1, 2004 (for Men) or later, June 1, 2004 (for Women) or later to qualify for the Championships.
- 3. Teams may be represented by Schools, LGU or Club following the guidelines on eligibility.
- 4. Entry fee of Two Thousand Pesos (PHP 2,000.00) to Ten Thousand Pesos (PHP 10,000.00) must be paid at least a week before the City/Provincial Finals to reserve the slot/s.
- 5. Format of the tournament may depend on the number of participating teams; if there are 7-10 teams participating, matches will be played in a pool system. Top 2 teams per pool shall advance to Quarter Finals. Winners of QF will continue for the semi-finals and SF winners to play in the Final round. If lesser or more teams participate, the organizers will formulate a system that is fair to all stakeholders.
- Drawing of Lots and Preliminary Inquiry will be based on the Regional (and Cluster) schedules (see on attachments).

Kindly email back the <u>a.) Entry Form</u> as well as <u>b.) Letter of Intent and Commitment to Participate</u> addressed to the undersigned at <u>hajanarnel@yahoo.com</u> which will be accepted starting September 30, 2024 and not later than the prescribed date of the Regional tournaments.

We look forward to welcoming you to the 1st PNVF U21 National Volleyball Championships 2025.
