POLICY GUIDELINES ON THE ALIGNMENT OF THE PROJECT LANGUAGE ENHANCEMENT THROUGH READING ASSESSMENT (LETRA) WITH THE PHILIPPINE INFORMAL READING INVENTORY KEY STAGE 3 TOOL

To: Assistant Regional Director Schools Division Superintendents This Region

- Pursuant to Regional Memorandum 640, s. 2024, Administration of CRLA, Phil IRI, and LETRA Tools and Submission of Beginning of School Year Reading Assessment Data and DM-CT-2024-447, Administration of Philippine Informal Reading Inventory (Phil IRI) for Key Stages 2 and 3 for School Year 2024-2025, the Regional Office IX through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) announces the Alignment of the Project LETRA with the Phil IRI Key Stage 3 Tool.
- The alignment aims to ensure that the regional reading initiative through the Project LETRA is aligned with the newly released Phil IRI for Junior High. The Language Enhancement Through Reading Assessment (LETRA) Tool is administered to all Grades 7 to 12 students for English and Filipino.
- The submission of the Project LETRA results was originally due on October 20, 2024. However, a new Phil-IRI tool for Junior High School was released in November 2024, with an orientation conducted on December 2, 2024. Consequently, this Office is issuing comprehensive guidelines on how to integrate and utilize the LETRA results alongside the Phil-IRI tool.
- This alignment will also standardize the administration and reporting processes, ensuring consistency with regional and national assessment protocols.

Enclosure to RM on the Policy Guidelines on the Alignment of the Project Language Enhancement Through Reading Assessment (LETRA) with the Philippine Informal Reading Inventory (Phil-IRI) Key Stage 3 Tool

1. Online Submission of Phil-IRI Results

- All schools (Grades 4-6 and Junior High) must submit Phil-IRI results online, as mandated by the Central Office.
- 2. Conduct of Phil-IRI Group Screening Test (GST)
 - Class advisers and/or language teachers will administer the Phil-IRI GST.

3. Alignment of LETRA Pretest Results

- LETRA pretest results will be aligned with Phil-IRI Forms 1 and 2.
- Learners who pass the GST will automatically be classified as independent readers if their LETRA results fall between Levels 6 and 9.
- Learners with LETRA results below Level 6, despite passing the GST, will be classified at the instructional level.
- Learners who do not pass the GST (scoring 27 or below for Junior High School) will be classified at either the instructional or frustration level, based on the interpretation provided.

4. Classification of Learners Based on GST

Learners who pass the GST will automatically be classified as independent readers.

5. Uniform Reporting

Schools must ensure uniformity in the report and interpretation of Phil-IRI results during submission.

6. Administration and Submission of Results

Results will be submitted per school using a designated link to be Phil IRI Grades 7 to 10 - Pretest - December 2024 - January 10, 2025 Posttest-March - April 2025

7. Uploading of Results

- School Reading Coordinators will upload results through the designated
- Division Reading Coordinators will generate results from the dashboard.

8. Details from LETRA and Phil-IRI Alignment

- Stage 1: All Junior High Schools must administer the Group Screening Test and place the results in Forms 1 and 2.
- Stage 2: Alignment of LETRA with Phil-IRI Individualized Assessment/Graded Passages (Pretest) will determine reading levels based on set criteria.


