REMINDERS FOR THE 2025 DEPED LRPO ANTI-OSAEC AND CSAEM CLASSROOM **BASED SESSIONS**









What is this initiative?

- In celebration of Safer Internet Day for Children.
- In compliance with R.A. 11930 (Anti-OSAEC and CSAEM law)
- Empower learners with resilience against Online Sexual Abuse and Exploitation of Children (OSAEC)
- · Promote safe and informed online behaviors.
- · Delivered via Classroom-based sessions led by class advisers.
- · Teachers are provided with presentation decks complete with guide scripts provided by the DepEd LRPO







Your Role as a Teacher

1. Customize the presentations

- Adapt provided decks to suit your learners, but retain all essential information.
- Use innovative teaching approaches to engage students.

2. Approach with Sensitivity

 Discuss the issue seriously but focus on empowering learners to feel safe and informed.

3. Use Age-Appropriate Language

 Adjust examples and terminology to your learners' developmental stage.





Creating a Safe Session Environment

1. Establish Agreements

Set respectful session rules to ensure a safe space.

2. Encourage Learner Openness

 Let students know they can approach you privately with questions or concerns.

3. Be Observant

Watch for non-verbal cues indicating discomfort or distress.

4. Be Prepared for Sensitive Discussions

 Use empathy and care when discussing as the presentation discusses violence against children.





Handling Disclosures

1. Confidential Yet Open Space

 Create a setting where the learner feels safe but avoid total privacy (e.g., no locked doors). DO NOT FACILITATE DISCLOSURE DURING THE ACTUAL SESSION.

2. Empathetic Listening

• Let learners speak at their own pace without judgment or interruption.

3. Reassure and Validate

• Praise their courage and emphasize that abuse is never their fault.

4. Explain Next Steps

• Clarify your duty to report their disclosure to the school head or guidance counselor to get them support.

5. Follow Reporting Protocols

Report cases following DepEd Order 40, s. 2012 (report to your guidance designate)





Self-Care for Teachers

1. Acknowledge Emotional Impact

 Recognize the stress and emotional toll of handling sensitive disclosures.

2. Seek Support

 Reach out to guidance personnel or peers for debriefing and emotional support.

3. Practice Self-Care

 Take intentional steps to manage stress and maintain well-being.



In compliance with Presidential Proclamation No. 417 "Declaring the Second Tuesday of February of Every Year as Safer Internet Day for Children [in the] Philippines," and in line with the promulgation of the Implementing Rules and Regulation (IRR) of Republic Act No. 11930, entitled "An Act Punishing Online Sexual Abuse or Exploitation of Children (OSAEC) and Anti-Child Sexual Abuse or Exploitation Materials (CSAEM)," the Department of Education (DepEd) is mandated to ensure the implementation of anti-OSAEC and CSAEM policy in schools through its Learner Rights and Protection Division (LRPD). In line thereto, the LRPD in collaboration with the Curriculum and Teaching Strand and in partnership with the Stairway Foundation Inc. proposes the conduct of a classroom-based learning session to increase awareness against OSAEC and CSAEM through integration in appropriate subject areas its core messages at the elementary and secondary levels.

These learning sessions will directly reach our learners, equipping them with knowledge and tools and increasing their awareness against OSAEC and CSAEM. The session guides can be accessed through this link: https://tinyurl.com/2025AntiOSAECDraft.

For guidance on how to implement the classroom-based session guides, an instructional video is prepared, kindly refer to this link: https://bit.lv/SIDPhOrientation.



Moreover, to ensure the implementation of anti-OSAEC and CSAEM policies in Schools, an instructional classroom-based session of the anti-OSAEC and CSAEM shall be conducted for each key stage and shall be delivered by the class advisers during their Homeroom subject. The classroom-based session shall be delivered during any day of March.

To ensure the effectiveness and efficiency of the conduct of the said activity, the different governance levels are expected to answer the data collection forms. Accordingly, in compliance with the Data Privacy Act, teacher-designates and guidance advocates who will be handling learner disclosure are requested to fill out the non-disclosure agreement.
