WEARING OF THE PRESCRIBED OFFICE ATTIRE AND THE UNIFORM OF THE DAY

- 1. Pursuant to Civil Service Commission (CSC) Memorandum Circular No. 16, s. 2024, dated November 29, 2024, otherwise known as the *Revised Dress Code for Government Officials and Employees*, and in line with DepEd Memorandum DM-OUHROD-2025-0052, all Teaching and Non-Teaching are hereby directed to strictly observe the prescribed office attire and uniform during official working days, **effective September 1, 2025**.
- 2. To ensure clarity and uniformity, the Civil Service Commission has prescribed the following official attire/uniform of the day.

Days without agency- prescribed office uniform			Smart Casual as defined under Section IV (H) and illustrated in Section V (A.4) of CSC MC No. 16, s. 2024.

- 3. Reasonable accommodation shall be given to employees with health conditions or special needs.
- 4. SDO Section Heads and School Heads are directed to monitor strict compliance with these guidelines. Any violation of the provisions of this Revised Dress Code shall be considered as ground for disciplinary action under civil service laws, rules, and regulations.
