
The highlight of the said celebration is the Simultaneous Twinkler Playday and Star Holiday on September 20, 2025 (Saturday) in celebration to the Escoda Day. Meanwhile Junior, Senior and Cadet Girl Scouts will be conducting the ESCODA CEREMONY on the said date.

The Annual Membership Fee of Girls, Troop Leaders, Barangay Committee, District Committee and Associate Member, will be increase from Php 50.00 to Php 60.00 and membership Fee for OAV (School Principal/School Head and District Supervisor) will be increase from Php 100.00 to 110.00 in response to the National Fund Drive of the Girl Scouts of the Philippines intended for the development of Camp Escoda (Josefa Llanes Escoda National Program and Training Center, or JLE NPTC).

Troop Leaders and Other Adult leaders who will be conducting and participating the said activity shall be given two (2) day service credit, for September 14 (SUNDAY) AND September 20 (SATURDAY), subject to the provision stipulated under DepEd Order No. 86 series of 2012 and DECS Memorandum No. 143 s. 1997.
