

DICT is expected to strengthen its nation's capacity-building efforts through ICT.  Given this, the ICT Literacy and Competency Development Bureau (ILCDB), the training arm of the DICT, is directed to:  "Promote digital literacy, ICT expertise, and knowledge-building among citizens to enable them to participate and compete in an evolving ICT age."
